


Antidepressant prescriptions in England, 2002 - 2012


All detentions under the Mental Health Act, all facilities, by year, 2007

Suicides in people aged 5 and over, registered in the United Kingdom, 2002-2012






Fear and exclusion of people with mental illness,

Understanding and tderance of mental illness, 2000-2012




- —We need to adopt a far more tolerant attitude toward people with mental illness in our society (% agreeing)
- —We have a responsibility to provide the best possible care for people with mental illness (% agreeing)





19,356 people through 1st stage consultation, questionnaires and ecampaigning 3999 people through in depth consultation; particpants can express views outside of fixed questions












Asda 'mental patient' costume withdrawn from sale online
