Name of Match: I-CIRCLE

Location of Match: Christchurch - virtual

Christchurch has experienced a series of disasters through two significant earthquakes in 2010/11, subsequent floods, the Port-hills fires and the horrendous March 15, 2019 terrorist attacks at two of our Mosques. The city's resilient, whole of community response to these events and subsequent growth, form the basis for shared learning and discovery of how a city can flourish in the face of adversity. following the Mosque shootings, the city demonstrated how Inclusion and Innovation can lead to Resilience and Growth. Systems and processes developed through those events hugely assisted the city and country to cope with the COVID-19 pandemic. This match aimed to share learnings from these events and to hear from other participating countries, to better equip us all to lead through disaster.
